3 Call to Order / Meet and GreetPhil Johnson, President

President Phil Johnson called the Regular Meeting of the LES PTA to order at 6:43 PM. All executive board members are present. There are twenty five (25) members and friends in the audience.

4 Approval of MinutesTom Boone, Secretary

Motion to accept the minutes of the June 4, 2007 Regular Meeting of the LES PTA was made by Aimee Spedaliere and seconded by Sandra Spedaliere. There was no discussion. Motion passed unanimously.

5 Report of the Treasurer.....Joy Occhialini, Treasurer

Outgoing Treasurer JoAnne Mackewicz presented the June 2007 and July/August 2007 Treasurer's Report. Of notable interest, \$87 in income for additional wrapping paper sales, \$1086.10 for SCRIP order, \$473.92 for SCRIP expenses, \$60 expense for childcare, \$25 in Fees & Insurance to the CT PTA, \$36.55 in Miscellaneous Expense, \$377.44 for 4th Grade Celebration expense, \$233.64 in Professional Programs for Scott Chesney, \$226.75 Publicity expense to pay for photo copying in the School, and \$478.15 in Sunshine expense for Teacher appreciation and parent/teacher conferences. Transferred \$4,500 into the CD for the Arts, \$2,500 into the CD for Savings and \$4250.58 was unrestricted from the Coffee for the Arts.

Of notable interest in the July/August 2007 Treasurer's Report is \$54.70 in President's expense for the summer LES PTA Executive Board dinner.

Motion to accept the June 2007 and the July/August 2007 Treasurer's Reports was made by Beth Pavlich and seconded by Lee Matson. There was no discussion. Motion passed unanimously.

LES Principal Sandye Simon reported that it has been an absolutely wonderful start to the School year. The Summer Reading Program was a huge success with 295 participating students who read over 12,000 books. Channel 3 came to school and prepared an article, which was aired on Friday (Sept 7) evening and Saturday (Sept 8) morning.

President Phil Johnson provided an overview of the LES PTA Committees. The LES PTA is searching for a chairperson for the Book Fair, Health & Safety Fair, Family Events, Fourth Grade Celebration, Ts and Sweats, New Initiatives, Book Cart and Spirit Week. Of course we are also looking for volunteers on these committees and for the rest of our committees.

A new committee is being formed this year in response to the 2007 survey results: Family Events. The Family Events committee is charged with organizing one Family Event for each School trimester. The Lady Bug Ball is one such event that this committee will organize.

The Worthington fundraiser is going out on Friday September 14.

We've changed SCRIP providers this year. We are now going with with Perk Werks. It is the same type of program except Perk Werks offers higher discount percentages and even more options (greater than 100 merchants). We will continue to offer on-hand inventory. Please see Phil Johnson, Laurie Shaw or Dede Lucey if you'd like to purchase SCRIP from the Inventory. SCRIP forms can be found on the LES PTA Website or in the binders outside the School office. Drop off completed forms, and money, in School office or directly with Phil Johnson. SCRIP pickup occurs after school within the School cafe or at the following LES PTA Regular Meeting.

A committee started in the Spring of 2007 and continuing this School year is the Bailey's Garden committee. This is a joint committee between the LES PTA and the Bailey's Garden committee chaired by Jim Shifrin. Jim Shifrin reported that the Bailey's Garden fund raised about \$6k from the Music Fest and \$11k from the Pride's Corner fundraiser, thereby increasing the fund to about \$71k. Phase 1 of the Bailey's Garden ADA compliant playscape will run about about \$58 and is slated for installation on October 6, 2007. The Bailey's Garden committee is seeking volunteers to help on Saturday October 6 with building Phase 1 for an AM crew (7:00-12:30) and a PM crew (12:30 - 6:00). Once a Trimester we'll have a "Bring a Friend" to an LES PTA Regular Meeting. At these meetings we'll award a second door prize.


