

1 Call to Order / Meet and GreetPhil Johnson, President

President Phil Johnson called the Regular Meeting of the LES PTA to order at 6:45 PM. All Executive Board members present. There are 19 friends and members in the audience.

2 Approval of MinutesTom Boone, Secretary

Motion to accept the minutes of the March 3, 2008 Regular meeting of the LES PTA was moved by Sandra Spedaliere and seconded by Laurie Blanch. There was no discussion. Motion passed unanimously.

3 Report of the Treasurer.....Joy Occhialini, Treasurer

Treasurer Joy Occhialini presented the February 2008 Treasurer's report. Of notable interest was, \$740 in SCRIP income and \$675 in Expense. \$35 for Childcare, \$187.64 in Misc Expense, \$60.34 in Publicity and \$51.49 in Reflections. \$18,025.57 balance in February.

Motion to accept the February 2008 Treasurer's Report was moved by Sandra Spedaliere and seconded by Dede Lucey. There was no discussion. Motion passed unanimously.

Treasurer Joy Occhialini presented the March 2008 Treasurer's report. Of notable interest was \$4,975.20 in Book Fair income, \$6.00 in PTA membership, and \$204.04 in Misc income. \$37.50 in Childcare, \$65.98 for Misc expense and \$2,690 for Teacher's gift.

Motion to accept the March 2008 Treasurer's Report was moved by Lisa Verizzi and seconded by Aimee Spedaliere. There was no discussion. Motion passed unanimously.

President Phil Johnson reported that the Bailey's Garden account has a balance of \$31,204, with no expenses or income during the month of February 2008.

Treasurer Joy Occhialini received a thank you from the teachers.

The 3 CD's were rolled over on 3/26 to a 7 month CD earning 3.10 interest.

Pfizer donations through United Way were received a thank you was mailed out to the people involved.

Several insufficient funds checks were received and Joy is contacting the appropriate people. These funds were for fundraising activities earlier in the year.

4 Principal's Report/Parent's Advisory Forum.....Sandye Simon, Principal

No report. President Phil Johnson mentioned that Sandye is looking at a potential speaker for our May meeting for Awareness.

5 Faculty Representative.....Gayle Solari

Gayle Solari reported a lot of thank yous for the Book Fair, for all classroom teacher gifts, and thank you for the delicious lunches during Parent / Teacher conferences. She has two (2) suggestions from Barbara Anderson, one was whether PTA is interested in supplying Daffadoil bulbs for flag pole circle where each student will plant a bulb, and the second suggestion is whether the PTA would be interested to provide the Academic calendars as in the past.

Motion to provide Academic calendars for the 2008/2009 year was moved by Laurie Blanch and seconded by Sandra Spedaliere. There was no discussion. Motion passed unanimously.

Field day is coming up in late May/early June.

Motion to provide Popsicles for Field Day was moved by Laurie Blanch and seconded by Lori Hermann. There was no discussion. Motion passed unanimously.

6 Committee Reports

4th Grade Celebration.....Barbara Starr

Chairperson Barbara Starr displayed the 4th grade celebration t-shirt and mentioned that a committee meeting will be held tonight.

Bailey's Garden.....Jim Shifrin

Chairperson Jim Shifrin reported that the Fun Run (5k, 3.1 mile) is coming up on May 4th starting the run at 1:30 at the School. Thank you to the PTA for covering the insurance costs for the Fun Run which is a tremendous help. The Polar Plunge, which was held recently, raised around \$2,000.

Book Fair.....Sandra Spedaliere

Chairperson Sandra Spedaliere reported that the Spring Book Fair did very well this year: \$6,298 in sales. We received \$629 worth of books. Picked 21 books for book cart and 27 hard back books. 14 Teachers filled out the wish list. Winner of the drawing was Ethan Wentworth in grade 3. We gave \$25 to Lebanon Kids and \$25 to Mrs. Anderson to use for the Library. We also have \$3,379 dollars in resource vouchers to be used.

Motion to spend up to \$400 was moved Kathy Fowler, seconded by Lori Hermann for the purchase of a book cart. During discussion, Kathy amended the motion for spend up to \$100 for a book cart, seconded by Lori Hermann. Motion passed unanimously.

Kathy Fowler will research it further to purchase and locate a book cart in an appropriate area at the School.

Motion for Sandra Spedaliere to place a "Donated by the PTA" sticker within each hard back book and distribute to each teacher was moved by Kathy Fowler and seconded by Dede Lucey.

Board of Education / Board of Finance.....Suzanne Yeo

President Phil Johnson reported that the BOE presented the 2008/2009 budget to BOF, which was \$16.9M. \$16.8M was approved by the BOF for 2008/2009 year. The reschedule date for the budget meeting looks to be the April 21st, but look for more information later this month.

Chairperson JoAnne Mackewicz reported that she is hoping to print out Butterfly sheets this week for Box Tops collection.

President Phil Johnson reported that the annual CT PTA convention will be held on May 1 and May 2 in Cromwell, CT.


